



After showing videos of revival among the young people in Honduras to 100 leaders of the Fellowship in Central America, the fire of God exploded in their hearts. Prophecies were given and plans were born. God seemed to be targeting Nicaragua.

Nicaragua, one of the poorest of all the Central American nations ... sixty percent unemployment, hunger, lack of education and bondage abound. As the leaders and I prayed, we believed that God could break that bondage and send great revival.

When I arrived in Nicaragua I experienced a very eerie feeling. There was a transportation strike and all public transportation had been shut down. There was considerable civil unrest in the city of Managua, and men were standing, ready for action, on the street corners with machine guns.

However, we proceeded with the plan the Lord had given us and met with our workers. We found they had already planned and prepared for 400 separate meetings within the nation. This was truly overwhelming. We had no idea so many meetings were scheduled.

And when we would complete a meeting at a school, business, or government office, someone in those facilities would approach us about having another meeting at another location. So the meetings continued to multiply during the week.

The youth groups from Honduras and Nicaragua worked fervently, going to many schools and universities throughout the nation. Before the week was over they had shared with approximately 30,000 students, and 24,353 had prayed to receive Christ.

Teams visited prisons, hospitals, nursing homes, businesses, and television stations, and held press conferences. They even met with the president of the country and had an opportunity to pray with him regarding his nation. They visited the poor and distributed food – especially to those that lived next to the city garbage dumps – and gave toys to the children.

We were given an opportunity to meet with the former President of Nicaragua, Daniel Ortega, and pray with him also. The way the Lord worked in that meeting was beyond our greatest expectations.

We had between 500 and 600 workers from other nations. By the end of the week there had been 925 meetings, and our best estimate of people who prayed to receive the Lord was approximately 97,000 people. In addition, there were about 200-300 more meetings scheduled for the following week.

This event was perhaps the greatest outpouring of the Spirit of God in the history of the Fellowship. It fulfills the prophetic word given the past few years, that this Fellowship would be used mightily in the last days' harvest. We have entered into our finest hour.

The results were overwhelming! We touched every level of society, from the top to the bottom. The Lord had prepared the hearts of the

It Continues to Grow

I have just returned from El Salvador where I met with FGBMFI National President, General Dionisio Machuca, and the chapter leaders of our Fellowship. These men heard about the revival in Nicaragua and invited their FGBMFI National President, Humberto Arguello, to come and testify about what happened on the Fire Teams' airlift.

He reported, "The FGBMFI in my country is no different than in any other nation. When Richard Shakarian told me that he felt God wanted to do a special work in my country I accepted the challenge because certain prophetic visions confirmed Richard's feelings. Nevertheless, as the planning for that week of revival developed, the men voiced concerns that the cost and coordination of a nation-wide

event would be staggering.

"Finally, I told my members: Each of you is responsible for setting up meetings for the week of revival. Go to the people you know in the factories, businesses, schools and government offices, and ask them if you can return with some of our FGBMFI men to share testimonies. When the revival week arrives, each of you will be responsible to spread the Fire Teams from other countries out amongst your meeting schedule. Let the Holy Spirit guide you!

"They did not know how they would be received, but everywhere they went doors were open and events were scheduled. All were astonished at the receptiveness everywhere they went. One man not only scheduled his

event but was also asked to share his testimony right then, on the spot. Over 250 persons opened their hearts to Jesus. Upon returning to report what had happened, this man told me, 'It's easier to bring a whole institution to Jesus than it is to invite one man to an FGBMFI dinner!'

"On the first day of the revival, there were riots in the streets of Nicaragua. It appeared that all revival plans were threatened. All the men and their families had been in prayer for weeks and now the enemy was trying to stop the miracle from taking place. Intercession took up weapons of warfare and the riots ceased that night. The next morning, all the events went forward as scheduled.

"The Fire Teams that arrived from other nations fanned out across the country with their Nicaraguan brethren. Everywhere they went, the doors and hearts of the people were open. As the testimonies were shared, men and women from every walk of life responded to the love of Jesus Christ.

"Our men ministered lovingly to the needs of the people in the power of the Holy Spirit. Miracles of healing, deliverance, and people receiving the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, were common. Every conceivable venue was the scene of God's love being poured out. From the President in his palace to the Sandinista Opposition leaders, prayer went forth over the nation. Forgiveness and restoration of families and old friends was notable. Schools, government offices, factories, business headquarters, police stations and military garrisons were all scenes of salvations, healings and deliverances.

God was reaching into every corner of Nicaragua!

"Weak chapters have found new fire, and new chapters have already been started. The men of the Fire Teams would return to the National Headquarters after every event, saying, 'They all gave their hearts to Jesus! And the miracles...!' It reminded everyone of the 70 disciples returning with joy to Jesus in Luke 10 saying, 'Even the devils are subject unto us through your name!' We imagined that Jesus rejoiced saying, 'I saw Satan fall like lightning in defeat!'

"This has come to change the FGBMFI in Nicaragua. The invitations keep coming in for the men to come to more meetings. The chapters will follow up the thousands who received Jesus so they too can become fishers of men. Each chapter has now created a new leadership position called 'Coordinator for External Events.' They know that the four walls of the

chapter no longer contain the Glory of God! Our men will continue to go out in the factories and offices, schools and government entities throughout the nation, taking testimonies of God's love to every corner of the country. Men and women from other nations that want to come to Nicaragua can do so and get in on the ongoing revival! You are welcome!

Within two years, every man, woman and child in Nicaragua will have had the opportunity to hear the Gospel and receive Jesus Christ in their heart through the witness of another person. It's what the Lord showed Demos in the word *International* of our name.

The Revival Spreads

As Humberto shared his nation’s testimony to the leaders of El Salvador, the men cried out for God to do the same in their country. The

date was set: June 18-19, 1999 in San Miguel, El Salvador.

The men began to go out to the cities and towns around San Miguel, setting up meetings where the men could come and share their testimonies during the convention dates.

Panama is preparing now for the revival to hit their country. In the meantime, the revival in Nicaragua goes on. It was not just for a week. Rather, it was a change in the way this ministry works. Instead of centering everything on the chapters, the ministry in each man was released outside of the walls of the chapters.


Just by taking the same testimonies that they were sharing in their chapters out to where the people are, almost 100,000 were touched with the Gospel in one week.

I have been travelling the world, encouraging the men of our Fellowship to believe the vision and know that God’s end-time plan of harvest is to use the laymen of the nations to bring in the souls. This particular strategy has demonstrated that God will use the vision to bring in the harvest! Truly, what God said to Demos and was recorded in his book *The Intensified Vision* is now being seen:

“Lord, where is that last revival that the prophets told us about? When are You going to move and do something?”

God said: “Demos, I’m waiting on you! I’ve given you My Son. I’ve given you His name. I’ve given you His authority. I can’t give you anything more. Go with what I’ve given you and that revival will break forth around you as you GO!”

THE VOICE OF THE LORD

“We know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose”, states Paul in Romans 8:28 (NKJ Version).

This scripture certainly stands out as one of my favorite verses and has helped to sustain me over the last 33 years spent confined to a wheelchair.

As a boy, I was raised by godly parents who did their best to raise me as God would want them to. My mother gave birth to me after more than nine years of marriage. Doctors had told her that she couldn't have children. But, after persistent prayer, the Lord honored her faith by granting her a son. She promptly had her perfectly healthy baby dedicated to the

Lord. I spent my elementary years attending an excellent Lutheran school, where the basics were taught along with much Bible study and memorization of scripture. This educational experience became an excellent foundation to build on.

I was raised in a Pentecostal atmosphere, where I developed a great respect and reverence for spiritual things. My youthful years were good ones, having a balance of church life, education and family recreation. At age nine,

I formally gave my life to the Lord and not long after, I experienced a healing. This left a lasting impression on my life, as did witnessing my mother's instantaneous miracle for diseased kidneys, which were supposed to take her life.

At age 17, nearing the completing of my senior year in high school, I broke my neck on the gymnasium trampoline. It was purely an accident, but one designed by Satan to end my life. Up till then I had been very athletic, the captain of the high school hockey team, but there I was, totally paralyzed from the upper chest region down – no feeling, no movement, nothing! In an instant, my life was changed forever.

In the hospital, my condition grew worse. My parents were advised that I would, most likely, not make it. And, if I did live, I would be left a virtual “basket case”, unable to do anything for myself.

I knew that I had experienced a serious spinal cord injury, and my mother felt that I was mature enough to share with me the doctor's

very negative prognosis. The report didn't bother me because my faith was anchored in God's Word and His promises. I felt strongly that no matter how serious the situation, my God could do anything. If He healed me once, He certainly could and would do it again. I was determined to prove the doctors wrong. After all, “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me” (*Philippians 4:13*).

Isaiah 26:3 promises: “You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You”. Then another, “Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all”. The Lord gave me His peace. I knew that I wouldn't die and that, in time, everything would work out just fine.

I was successful in maintaining a good attitude, realizing that by being cheery, it would certainly help my parents to adjust to the trauma as well. The huge medical expenses far exceeded my parents' basic health insurance, and together we prayed and trusted the Lord for monies from unexpected sources. Once the school trampoline accident hit the television news and local papers, we experienced a tremendous outpouring and response from hundreds of people, strangers who sent cards and notes with varying amounts of money. Mail time became a blessing every day. We praised God for the wonders He performed. Our faith was strengthened even more.

Upon returning home, I was determined to resume as normal a life as possible. I went back into sales and quickly became totally independent financially.

Though I couldn't drive, my parents had kept my new Ford convertible that I had had prior to my injury. For more than a year, a benevolent gentleman sent a monthly check that was sufficient to cover the car payment.

During the fourteen years that I lived with my parents, I was most fortunate to live a rather "normal life". Eventually, I developed three businesses and earned a good income, always remembering to tithe and to give offerings. Though I didn't drive, I had an active social life and had many friends who were delighted to drive Roger's new cars. My parents were, in most cases, very supportive in my desire to lead a normal life, and I'm thankful for that.

If I was to appear on the old TV program named "What's My Line"; I would surely have

won for lack of their correct answer. I functioned as a licensed private investigator in Ohio for 22 years, operating a good-sized private police agency, and also as the school commander and certified law enforcement instructor at a state-licensed police academy for 14 years.

While on patrol one evening in the month of October, it was rainy and cold. We were driving through Cleveland's Inner Belt that would soon connect us with the interstate when an audible voice said to me, "Pray, there is danger ahead."

I was dumbfounded. I had never experienced anything like this before. I ignored the experience as some kind of mental aberration. Then I heard it again, this time more persistently, "Pray! There is danger ahead." This time the voice of the Holy Spirit got my full attention. I said a silent prayer for the Lord's protection as we now traveled east on the interstate.

My driver, Dennis, noticed a traffic accident on the opposite side, so he directed the car to the very next exit. As he

applied the brakes, the car evidently struck an oily substance that caused the car to go into an instant, uncontrolled spin, spinning around and around with other cars in front and in back of us. Praise God, His angel was there, controlling that spin. Suddenly the car struck the curbing sideways and bounced over, ripping up strips of grass and coming to a sudden stop just three feet short of a steel utility pole that could easily have crushed me in my seat. Upon inspection, we found that the car had completely escaped damage and there was no injury. Instead of being shaken, as Dennis was, I was in perfect peace.

As we left that area, I related the experience I had

had to Dennis. His reply was direct and to the point: "If you EVER hear a voice like that again, you pray right away, okay?" I began to realize that, essentially, nothing moves in heaven on our behalf without a petition of prayer. John 14:14 assures us that, "If you ask anything in My name, I will do it".

Marriage was the last thing on my mind when I met Kathy on a date arranged by my driver Dennis. He was married to Kathy's sister at the time, so he and Darlene arranged a double date for a September evening.

Though I had dated some very fine young women, I couldn't imagine any woman who would permit herself to fall in love with a quadriplegic, confined to a wheelchair. I had always prayed that the Lord would bring His choice for a wife into my life, AFTER my healing. However, the gentle Spirit of the Lord showed me that I was praying in error. My new prayer was, "Lord, if there is a special lady out there that You have in mind for me and she can look beyond the paralysis and really fall in love with 'the man', I'd sure like to meet her."

Here I was, on my first blind date, a double date with a very pretty lady named Kathy. We dined at a fine restaurant and, while eating and carrying on a rather casual conversation, an audible voice said to me, "She shall become your wife". I thought I was losing my marbles for sure. After all, this was my first date.

We dated casually for a few weeks until my parents and I went to Florida for our winter vacation. During my absence, Kathy began to date another man. Upon returning home, I was informed of this through Dennis. He broke the

news to me that Kathy was engaged to Steve. I assured him that I was not concerned. Confidently, I told him the engagement would not last and we would be getting back together again soon. He asked, "Well, how do you know, Rog?" I smiled back and said, "Dennis, I just know it. Wait and see".

Kathy and I did get back together again within a month. By March of 1974, we were engaged, and then married on June 29th. After more than 25 years of marriage, I continue to thank the Lord, daily, for His many blessings. Kathy and I have had a good, loving marriage. We have experienced numerous answers to prayer. We have seen many of our dreams come true over the years. As with any marriage, we have experienced various trials and tribulations, as everybody does, but by keeping our faith in the Lord, using the power of prayer along with our heavenly language, we have become victorious over the enemy.

Kathy and I lived in a beautiful barrier-free home in a suburb of Cleveland for 16 years, a home that the Lord beautifully supplied to us as the result of prayer. It had everything that Kathy and I had on our "wish list", including the trees in the yard.

In 1987, the Lord permitted us to purchase a second residence in southwest Florida. In 1992, we closed the chapter in our lives up north by selling our home and businesses and opened a "new chapter" in Florida, where we design and build barrier-free homes for the physically challenged. A new ministry is opening for us as we meet many physically handicapped persons, some of whom are desperate



for answers in life. Some have lost faith in receiving any answer from God.

Some ask me, "Roger, do you still believe that God will heal you after so many years?" My answer is an emphatic "yes".

So many prayers have been answered that I know, without doubt, that in God's appointed time, I will be delivered from paralysis. My job is to trust the Lord and let Him be Lord. Never once has He let us down. His Word has always been faithful. I will continue to trust in the Lord, and I know that He will direct my path. God has our very best interests in mind and is working on our behalf.



Witnessing at Work

The month of June, 1936 was hot and humid. At that time I was a 10-year-old farm boy, and I was feeling miserable. A couple of lies I had told my parents were beginning to torment my conscience.

Being 60 miles from home with my father, drawing in hay at the farm my dad had just purchased, didn't help. One evening, with supper over, dad was exhausted and almost ready for bed, but my grandmother, who lived nearby, had invited me to attend their revival. Mr. Hewitt, a neighbor, was picking her up first, and then me.

To me, Mr. Hewitt's 1934 Chevrolet was a limousine roaring to a halt beside our tiny, Model-T Ford. He and his family were crowded inside with my grandmother.

Opening the car doors when we arrived, the sound of singing floated down from the open

windows of the little country church. As we climbed out, a warm, night breeze hit our faces, wipping our hair awry. Climbing the half-dozen cement steps to the entryway, we could see the church was almost full. The gas lamps in the fixtures on the wall were "sputtering" and "hissing," emitting a brilliant, white light, too bright to stare at.

Always bashful, looking down, I watched the others out of the corner of my eyes. Ladies were waving their fans back and forth, attempting to keep cool, while their husbands wiped sweaty brows

with large handkerchiefs.

The young evangelist bounded to his feet and began preaching. Pacing back and forth across the platform, his white shirt drenched with sweat, he warned again and again about the “fires of hell.”

Somehow, it seemed like he must have found out about the lies I had told my parents, because when he referred to the “fires of hell,” he would look down at me.

The organist began pumping the old organ with her feet and the hymn, *Just As I Am*, sounded forth. The congregation rose to their feet and began singing, “Just as I am without one plea, But that Thy blood was shed for me...”

When they began to sing the second stanza I felt a gentle tap on my shoulder as my grandmother leaned over and asked, “Arthur, do you want to get saved?”

Nodding yes, I stepped into the aisle, and walked to the altar. Kneeling down, tears began to slip out of my closed eyelids. Behind me, I could hear the congregation singing, “Oh Lamb of God, I come! I come!”

Tears were running freely down my face as I told Jesus how sorry I was for my sins, and asked Him to save me. Immediately, I felt Jesus reach down and lift the terrible burden of sin, shame and guilt up from my shoulders. Then it was gone! In its place was an unspeakable joy. I felt clean! Oh, how I loved Jesus, and I wanted everyone to know.

Speaking out In Business

In today's world of materialism and compromise, some people say, “It's not as easy or as important to practice Christian ethics in business today as it was fifty years ago. It's ‘dog-eat-dog’ out there. You'll never survive if you're not ruthless and strong.”

In business or out of business, the Christian who remains true to God's Word will have many opportunities to witness for Jesus Christ and “go the extra mile” for a client.

During the past thirty-two years in my business situations, Christ has given me numerous opportunities to meet many fine Christians and to witness to people who don't know Jesus. One morning a number of years ago, as I studied my Bible as usual from 7:30 to 8:00 a.m., with my office door open, a middle-aged couple and a young lady came in. “Are you open for business?” the man asked, smiling.

“I sure am,” I answered, closing my Bible. “What can I do for you folks?”

“We're looking for a duplex,” answered the young lady, “My folks and I are buying it together. We live in Pontiac, but I just got a

teaching job here at the school.”

“You’re going to like it here in Imlay City,” I replied. “We have a couple duplexes. Let me make some phone calls.”

I made the calls. We previewed both duplexes, and they purchased the second one. During the five weeks it took to close the sale, the four of us enjoyed times of genuine fellowship on three occasions. The daughter and her parents were Christians.

A few years later, the young lady and her husband came into my office. They had just been married and had some papers to be notarized. We were enjoying fellowship around our Savior again when she asked, “Art, do you know the reason my folks and I decided to buy our duplex from you?”

“No,” I answered.

“We figured that we could trust someone who spent time studying his Bible in his office at 8:00 in the morning – and we were right,” she replied.

Taped to the dash of my car on the passenger side is a three-word message, “Jesus Is Lord.” Lying in a holder between the front seats is a stack of gospel tracts. I started giving out gospel tracts in 1960, and I have handed out thousands since then.

When I take clients to preview properties and they notice the little sign and gospel tracts, they keep their conversation clean, and no one requests permission to smoke in the car. Often God opens the way to witness when

a client asks a spiritual question or remarks about my “Jesus Is Lord” sign.

Stand beside Jesus on Calvary’s hill regardless of the cost. It is worth the effort, for it doesn’t really cost to serve Jesus. It pays to tell others about Him.

It is right to witness for Jesus in your business because Christians don’t own their businesses; God does. More than thirty years ago I agreed with my Savior that I, and anything and everything I owned, belonged to Him. He’s been taking care of me and my business ever since.

“In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths”
(Prov. 3:6).

In other words, it is possible to "leave it all to the children," and make a significant, charitable gift at the same time. Here are just three possibilities:

1. **Wealth Replacement Life Insurance:** The individual uses a non-income-producing, highly appreciated asset, like nonproductive real estate, to fund a charitable remainder trust. The trustee of the trust sells the asset and reinvests the proceeds in a balanced portfolio of income-producing securities which provide enough annual income to the individual to meet the payout requirements of the trust. He then uses the income tax benefits and the income produced by the trust to fund an irrevocable life insurance trust using special provisions in the tax code. When the individual dies, the remaining assets of the trust pass to the qualified charity or charities named in the trust. At the same time, the life insurance trust pays a death benefit to the individual's children. These plans can be structured to provide the children with proceeds equal to, or greater than, the value of the real estate. It's a win-win arrangement.
2. **Charitable Remainder Trust With Extended Payments:** In this scenario, the individual creates a charitable remainder trust (see above) and adds a term of years to the trust payout period. That is, after the individual who has been receiving income from the trust dies, the trust continues to "live" for a period of years. During these added years, the trust provides the children with income. The accumulated value of this additional income can approximate the value of the asset originally used by the individual to fund the trust.
3. **Charitable Lead Trust With Remainder to Children:** This charitable giving vehicle is the reverse of the charitable remainder trust. Instead of the charity receiving the remainder of the trust, it receives income payments from the trust for a limited period of time. After its specified term, whatever is left in the trust (the remainder) passes to the children. This technique can be especially useful when the asset involves stock that is expected to appreciate significantly in the future.

All three of these charitable gift plans outlined here require the assistance of a qualified professional for specific and authoritative application. A Special Mission In Business

As I grew up, I had the privilege of attending some of the most prestigious private schools in our country. As a matter of fact, I went to the same high school as our Swedish king. Most of my family were very devout Christians. However, I found church rather boring and preferred playing football. It was not that I went through any sort of rebellion. Rather, it was simply that I saw little that excited me in the church. Although I was no world star, I played with a good team. For me it was just plain fun.

In school, I was a top student, but football was my love. I never thought much about life. The World Cup Soccer games in Argentina in 1978 was a very important event for me. I can still remember the final play. At a very exciting point, the score standing 1/1, I was sitting there, totally engrossed in the game when the door bell suddenly rang. I looked over at my twin

brother and complained about being disturbed at such a crucial moment.

It was my uncle, who was a retired Baptist pastor and lived in another town. He had been unable to come to our graduation party and was stopping by to congratulate us on our excellent accomplishments. Not realizing the importance of the game, he stood right in front of the TV. He explained that he wanted to give us a graduation gift, which seemed very kind. We had already received many wonderful presents.

Still standing between us and the game, he handed each of us a small red Gideon Bible. At the time, the only thing I could think of was, "Move, I can't see the TV."

When he handed us the Bibles, we said impatiently, "Thank you, thank you!" He finally got the message and moved!

Before going on to university, I had to do my national service. Although I rarely attended church at the time, I packed that little red Gideon Bible. As it turned out, I spent nine months of the next year out in the wilderness near the Arctic Circle. It always seemed to be cold and dark. I had plenty of time on my hands; it was very boring! For the first time I started thinking about the meaning of life and actually began reading the Bible.

My twin brother, who was posted to the same place as me, and I started attending some church meetings in a nearby town. While visiting those meetings, I heard people giving testimonies about a living God. Someone had even been healed. They talked about God in personal terms. He had done miracles in their lives. This fascinated me and sparked quite a number of discussions with my brother concerning Christianity. Could it really be true?

After military service we began studying economics and business administration at one of the very best schools in Sweden. Somewhat intrigued by Christian issues after my experience up North, I agreed to attend a Bible study in my parents' church. Then one day my brother came to me and said, "Listen, I know how to get saved! It is explained in the back of the little red Bible." He was referring to making a commitment to Jesus Christ.

I'd heard of this before, but could never accept the fact that I was a sinner and needed to be forgiven by God. I was very proud, and

had always thought I was better than other people. However, in the back of that little red Bible was a list of Bible verses. As I read through them I became convinced that I was indeed in rebellion against God by not serving Him as Lord of my life, and was therefore a sinner. I then prayed the prayer printed at the end of that list, asking Jesus to forgive my sins and be Lord and leader of my life.

Everything I could find out about Jesus seemed to be true. Thus I also had to accept Him for what He claimed to be, namely the 'Son of God', who had come to reconcile man to God. There were no bolts of lightning, yet

something changed on the inside. Up till then I had found the Bible difficult to understand. Now it was as if the book had come alive. The words seemed to jump right off the page.

Shortly after this a Bible study group started on campus. So much had changed, yet, when the leader of the student Christian group started encouraging us to share about Jesus with other students, and even perhaps to have an information table, we exclaimed, "You can't do that! This is the Stockholm School of Economics!" Finally, as a compromise, we made a list of all our names and hung it on a bulletin board, inviting those who were interested to come and see us.

Of course my friends saw my name there and wanted to know what it was about. My best friend said, "Hey, I didn't know you were a Christian. You look pretty normal. How can you be a Christian?" Somewhat embarrassed, I said, "It runs in the family," as if it was a disease or something. Besides, he didn't seem to have it running in his fami-

ly. It was a terrible answer, but it was a beginning.

At first I didn't want to get too excited lest I become a fanatic, but the more we studied the Bible and saw how fascinating Jesus was, the more excited I became. I remember a few real turning points. On one occasion our Bible study conflicted with a football game, and I had to decide what was more important to me. I chose to focus on getting to know Jesus better. My priorities were changing!

Then, we started studying the book of Acts in the Bible. We read about the Holy Spirit and about the many miracles which took place among the early Christians. What I couldn't understand was why I wasn't seeing miracles today. There seemed to be no reason why we should not still be seeing them. I wanted to experience the kind of power those early Christians had. So I started praying for just that.

Every week we would receive notes on the Bible study for the next week so we could come prepared. On one occasion there was a heading, 'How to Receive the Holy

Spirit'. That week my brother came into my room very excited about the results of the hand-out. He'd been through it and had received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. Well, I wanted what the early Christians had, so I quickly went through it myself and prayed that God would also fill me with His Holy Spirit. To my disappointment, nothing happened.

A week later my grandmother celebrated her 90th birthday. As I mentioned earlier, I come from a Christian background. At the party we began singing a few Christian songs when suddenly something strange came over me. I left the others and locked myself in the bathroom. Then and there I received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. It was wonderful! Laying in bed that night, I thanked God for the special gift He'd given me.

Lying there in bed, a power flowed through

my body like electricity. When I had first committed my life to Jesus Christ, everything had been very logical. Now I encountered God in a new way. It can only be described as a baptism of power. This really made the difference in my life; it changed me! Something similar had happened to many other members of our Bible study and it changed us all. We used to be very quiet about our faith, not even wanting to have a book table. We were afraid. Now everything was different. We set up a book table, from which we sold Bibles and handed out pamphlets telling about Jesus. We began witnessing to the professors, and invited other students to join us for lunch prayer meetings.

I remember speaking to the Freshmen student body, telling them that one book was

missing on the semester's required reading list – 'The Bible'. I then invited them to join our Bible studies and remedy this. We saw tremendous growth. What we'd thought was impossible was bringing fruit – sharing the good news about Jesus at such a prestigious business institute as ours.

The people who had inspired our Christian group on campus had seen us as the future business leaders of Sweden and felt that it was very important to establish our Christian faith now. One of them introduced us to the Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship International (FGBMFI) and gave us some copies of Voice magazine.

I remember reading all the testimonies in those Voice magazines. They were tremendously fascinating stories! After graduation I got a Fulbright Scholarship to do post-graduate studies in the USA. While there in Providence, Rhode Island, I attended FGBMFI meetings. I was convinced that God had called me to be a Christian business man, and that this

would involve me with the FGBMFI in some way.

After returning from the United States, I landed a good job in banking where I am still working today. God has blessed my professional life, and I am a Vice-President with Sweden's largest commercial bank. I work as a Financial Controller, but that is not the most important thing in my life. It is serving God that excites me.

Back in Sweden, I was convinced that God wanted me to get involved with the FGBMFI. When I finally tracked them down, though, to my disappointment, they mostly invited preachers to speak and had little interest in reaching business men.

As a result, for a number

of years I had little to do with the FGBMFI meetings, although I was a member. Then, two years ago, God seemed to renew my vision to reach business men. I met friends who'd been strong Christians and were now very successful and spent their Sunday mornings on the golf course. Slowly a group of us got together with a similar idea — to share Jesus Christ with the business world.

We thought of the FGBMFI, but the chapter in our city had lost its direction. Just as we were planning to go ahead on our own, the leaders of the FGBMFI contacted us and asked us to join them and help get the Stockholm Chapter moving again. They said it needed a young president with vision. They had also spoken to some other young Christian business men about becoming involved. For eight years I had known that one day I would be involved with the FGBMFI. Now the timing seemed to be right and I accepted.

We now have a growing chapter in Stockholm — one that reaches out to business men. We invite speakers who are business men, and they share what God has done for them. It is wonderful! We have many business people attending now. Things are happening and we are so thankful.
